

The fact is, the teaching trip would never have been possible apart from you who support us.

And yet in coming weeks, my heart is turning more and more towards Latin America. During February I'll travel to the Central American nations of Belize and Guatemala, and during March to South America, visiting Peru and Ecuador. I'll also deliver two Spanish webcasts in Latin America (through Mexico City) on the subject of *What Happens After We Die?*, thanks to my translator, friend, and fellow teacher, Arturo Elizarrarás,
