

### **PRINCETON** (APRIL)

One of the coolest things this year has to be was speaking at Princeton. This was my first time on this prestigious campus. The university invited me to lecture on *Is Christianity Rational: A Critical Study of the Life and Teachings of Jesus Christ.* Sounds academic (maybe), but it was exciting, and faith-building. The lecture theatre was packed with 200 persons!

This was such fun that the same topic was selected for my 10 September **debate** against Finnish atheist Robert Brotherus, to be held in Helsinki. ### **PEPPERDINE** (MAY & JUNE)

This spring I twice visited the beautiful campus of Pepperdine University, once was for the annual Bible lectures (I taught a on Jesus & Islam), and again for the annual Christian Scholars' Conference. More than 500 scholars came to California to hear such great scientists as British physicist **John Polkingorne** (Oxford) and **Francis Collins** (Director of the Human Genome Project and head of the National Institutes

of Health, where I used to lead a Bible study). Both these men have contributed greatly to the field of Christian evidences. Francis is probably the most recognizable scientist today in the US. What a privilege to finally meet him! After he signed my old copy of his book *The Language of God*, I managed to put my felt-tip pen back in my jacket pocket without the cap on. All seemed well, as I blithely smiled for the photo (right)--little did I know that my jacket was rapidly absorbing blue ink, and only narrowly escaping destruction. (My shirt was a lost cause. Alas!) The conference was for my own **continuing education**. I feel strongly that all my fellow preachers and teachers stand to benefit greatly from continuing ed -- and the people you speak to deserve your commitment to keep learning.



### **PUBLISHING** (JULY)

Your Bible Questions Answered was released 3 weeks ago. This book came into being through correspondence with you, as well from parts of as my earlier DPI books Q&A and Q&A II and the 1300 Q&As at my website. I told many of you that it would be carried by Barnes & Noble (who carry my first two HH books), but we just learned of an unexpected decision not to carry it -- to be appealed in February. (Sorry.)

To promote the book, Harvest House has set up a series of **radio interviews**, beginning tomorrow and running into October. I just might be on the air in your area! Interviews are currently slated for stations in Florida, Ohio, Oregon, Michigan (x2), and California, though there will be many more. Back in February Harvest House published *The Ultimate Bible Quiz Book*. Last night after church a friend told me he'd seen it at a Publix supermarket. It's long been my dream that the books would penetrate the larger Christian world, and this is beginning to happen.

I average one new podcast a week. A number of new lessons -- 30 this year -- are available at the second website, jacobypremium.com. Here's a sampling:

- **Harry Potter** -- How might the world of wizarding magic be a good thing for Christians? <u>Click</u> to find out (free podcast).
- **Armageddon** -- Is it a literal battle or not? How should we read Revelation 16:16?
- The 4th of July -- For Americans, what should be the true meaning of the day?
- Why God Sent a Son (and not a Daughter) -- It isn't chauvinism or patriarchy; God sending a Son (a man) was integral to the mission. Find out why. This is another of the free podcasts which I recorded yesterday. Click here.
- **Birthdays** -- are they unbiblical, as the Jehovah's Witnesses claim? What can we learn from the few birthdays in the Bible?
- The Antichrist -- This is one of 9 podcasts in a series on Last Things. Hint: Antichrist is not a person!

- After the **ICMC** in Athens, taught Church History (**AIM**) along with Ed Anton, Sam Laing, and Joey Harris.
- Shared missions minutes in **Jacksonville** (my hometown in Florida)--who have a new evangelist, Jamie Robbins of Vancouver.
- Also enjoyed teaching 200 **Chicago teens** (Skype).
- On Tuesday sent off the manuscript for the next book, *The Quick Bible Overview: How All the Pieces Fit Together* (March 2012).
- Teaching a **local Bible study** series on "How Much Time is Left?" Great to see so many guests coming to the discussions!
- And in a couple of weeks I'll teach **Latin America** by WebEx. Subject: *Christianity & the Paranormal*.
