



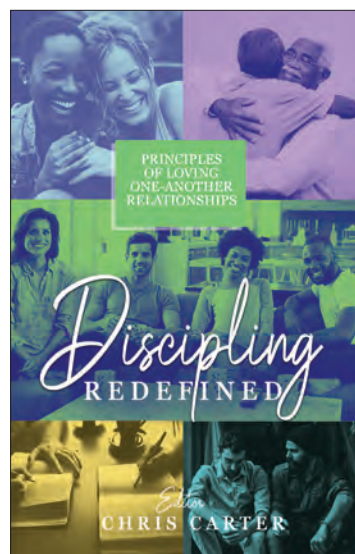
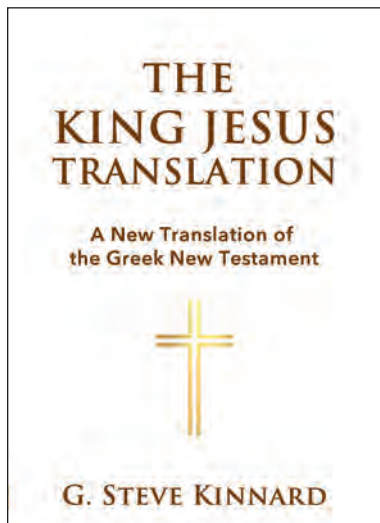
## GOD, ARE WE GOOD?
